

Create your own...
3D Christmas Card

You will need:

- Purple and white card
- Scissors
- Glue or Pritt stick
- Felt tip pens
- Ribbons
- An adult to help
- Any other decorations!





How to make



Firstly, fold your purple card in half. Use any other coloured card if you prefer!



Next, draw four lines at the back of your card and carefully cut them in a straight line. The top should be shorter with the middle being the longest line. Use the image as reference.



With your lines cut - fold the card accordingly. They should form three cube-sized squares as the image above.



When you open up the card, it should form a 3D shape as above.



Next, stick the purple card onto some plain white card - only glueing the edges and leaving the middle untouched. This will allow your card to pop-out!



Get some plain paper and cut them to the shape and size of your 3D pop-out cubes. Then draw some patterns on them - or any other messaging if you prefer.



Stick your design onto the pop-out cubes and wait for them to dry.



Finally, decorate your pop-out with ribbons or any other decorations that you like! Don't forget to write a message and you have your very own 3D Christmas Card!
